

 - Strengthen the link between transportation and land use in municipal master plans







Municipal Land Use Center at The College of New Jersey

Conventional Zoning







 - Convene Policy Advisory Group
 - Create criteria and list of candidate municipalities
 - Select 5 10 municipalities
 - Conduct outreach & education
 - Hire "designated" consultants to work with each municipality
 - Create Municipal Project Teams consisting of municipal staff, designated consultant and MLUC staff
